Notice of Approval

Relocation of La Jolla Post Office

The U.S. Postal Service (USPS) has approved the relocation of the La Jolla Post Office, located at 1140 Wall Street, to a yet-to-be-determined location as close to the current site as possible. There will be no change to La Jolla Post Office Box numbers or ZIP Codes.

USPS plans to sell the Post Office building on Wall Street after operations are relocated. The building will also be marketed for a potential sale/lease back. An implementation date for the move has not been established at this time.

This cost-reduction and revenue-generation plan is part of a nationwide response by the Postal Service to maintain universal service and operate more efficiently in the face of dramatic decreases in mail volume and other economic factors that have caused net losses of over \$25 billion in the past five years. USPS does not receive tax dollars for its operations or facilities.

This decision may be appealed for 15 days from the date of this posting. An appeal must be postmarked by April 6, 2013, and mailed to:
