Employee Update – As always, our goal is to keep New York District employees informed and updated on changes to our facilities. Earlier this year we informed you about a public meeting held on April 22, 2013, regarding the USPS plans to relocate the retail services of the Peter Stuyvesant Station located at 432 East 14th Street, New York, NY.

In accordance with the procedures set forth at 39 C.F.R. 241.4, upon further assessment and review, the Postal Service has made a determination to proceed with the relocation of retail services. This determination is not final and is subject to review by the Vice President of Facilities.

Elected officials are being notified which gives them and anyone the opportunity to appeal this decision within thirty days of the date of the letter. Such requests for appeal must be in writing, identify the post office by name or location, identify the decision objected to, and state the reason for the objection. The request should be directed to Voice President, Facilities and addressed as follows:
